










"Since last year I have been mentoring through Global Mentorship Initiative. GMI partners business professionals with underserved students to provide online (via Zoom) mentoring in business skills, job hunting, interview prep, etc. It is a structured program of 14 mentoring sessions that I schedule at the mutual convenience of my mentee and me. I recently completed the program with a young man in Rwanda and am now mentoring a stats/econ major in Jamaica. Many of the students are in Africa but some are in other countries including the US. 




